SUBJECT: Intern Eligibility Letter

This letter is to confirm that Natalay Goldstein is eligible for the Los Angeles County Office of Education **District Intern Single Subject - English** credential. The **EL** requirements will be embedded in the district intern credential.

This letter of eligibility is not an official acceptance letter to the district intern program. The official letter of acceptance is provided when the following items have been submitted:

- Provide an official letter of employment or intent to hire from a local district or charter for the 2019-20 school year. The letter must indicate that the position is full-time and that the candidate will be the teacher of record. The position must also match the credential the candidate is wishing to earn.
  - **The deadline for verification of employment is due to LACOE no later than August 29, 2019.**
- District contract/agreement is on file with the Los Angeles County Office of Education.

If the district of employment is not currently under contract with LACOE, the district may contact our office to discuss a memorandum of understanding with the Los Angeles County Office of Education District Intern program.

The LACOE District Intern program is in high demand. All applications must be submitted before program orientation or before the program is full. Any applications submitted after these deadlines may be considered for next year's enrollment, at the candidate's request. It is critical that all potential candidates submit their applications as early as possible to improve their chances of official acceptance into the program.
